Inspired by the ancient Chinese tradition, this fall event of the Montréal Botanical Garden has been enchanting us since its creation. Glittering lanterns of various shapes illuminate the Chinese Garden and the eyes of thousands of visitors who come to enjoy the magical spectacle. Artisans in the Shanghai region make each lantern by hand, following the technical drawings designed here, in Montréal. It takes over a month to set up this marvelous decor that uses a green technology to light the lanterns.

This autumn event sets three cultural gardens at the Botanical Garden all aglow. The Chinese Garden displays its traditional lanterns and shares with visitors a fabulous fishing tale, the Japanese Garden leads visitors along a meditative illuminated path inspired by the seasons, and the First Nations Garden features an intense multimedia experience that lets visitors feel the beating heart of the Cycle of Life.

For an even more enchanting visit, plan to arrive in the late afternoon to admire the blooms and fall colours.
